Pre-anesthetic blood work is required for ALL pets over 3 years of age, and is highly recommended regardless of age.

The information we get from this lab work tells us how well your pet's major organs will be able to process anesthesia. It helps to reduce anesthetic risk, helps us to check your pet's health, and gives us a baseline for comparison in case of future illnesses and aging changes.

- Health Screen I** (6 months – 3 years): Checks hydration, liver and kidney function and blood sugar levels (\$77) This profile is required for all pets over 3 years of age; it is only optional for younger pets.

***Depending on your pet's age and doctor's recommendations, blood work may be substituted for the Health Screen I.** Initial here if you prefer to decline blood work _____

- Health Screen II** (3 years – 6 years): Health Screen I + complete blood count (\$103)
- Health Screen III** (over 6 years old): Comprehensive serum biochemistry profile including pancreatic function + complete blood count (\$139)
